the Procurement Act



The Procurement Act 2023 extends the ground for bidder exclusion due to past poor performance.

Have you taken stock of your current performance under your public contracts and identified any areas of exclusion risk?

KPIs

For most public contracts worth more than **£5 million**, the Act requires least three KPIs to be set and published. Your performance against those KPIs will be published annually.

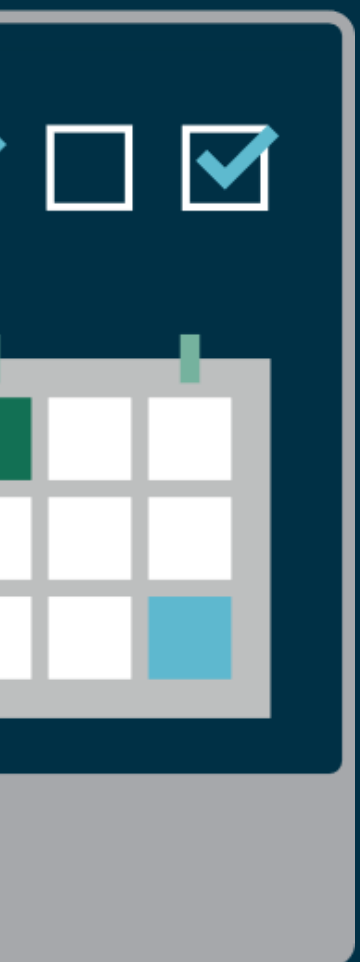
Are you ready for extra transparency around your KPI performance?



Settlements

Entering into a settlement agreement in relation to a public contract will be a new trigger for potential exclusion under the Act.

Transitional arrangements

Current guidance indicates that all procurements started prior to the Procurement Act 2023 coming into force shall continue under the provisions of the prior Regulations.
